- 3. Assessing of the risks that cannot be avoided and limiting of the risks at the source of their occurrence.
- 4. Indicating of existing dangers and sources of factors harmful to health, safety and environment.
- 5. Implementating of a consistent comprehensive policy for prevention, covering the technology, the organization of work, the working conditions, the social relations and the impact of the elements of the working environment and the labor process.
